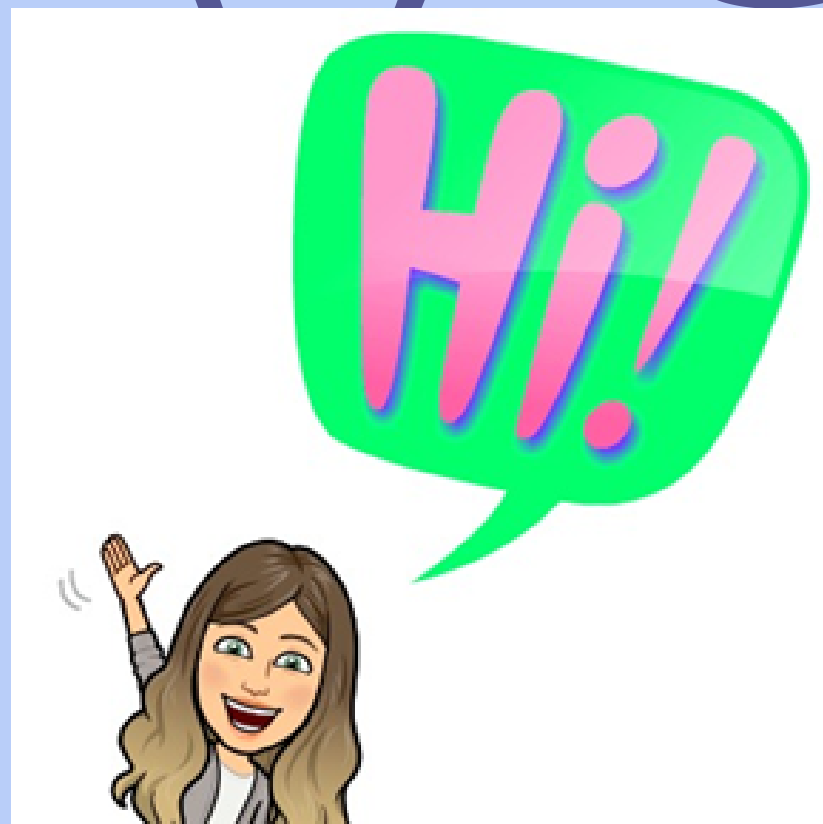

outcomes

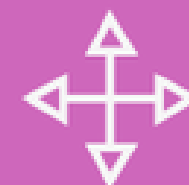


Develop core curriculum

### Unless:

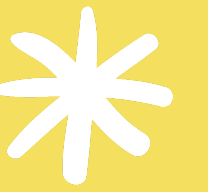
Algebra 1 or Civics

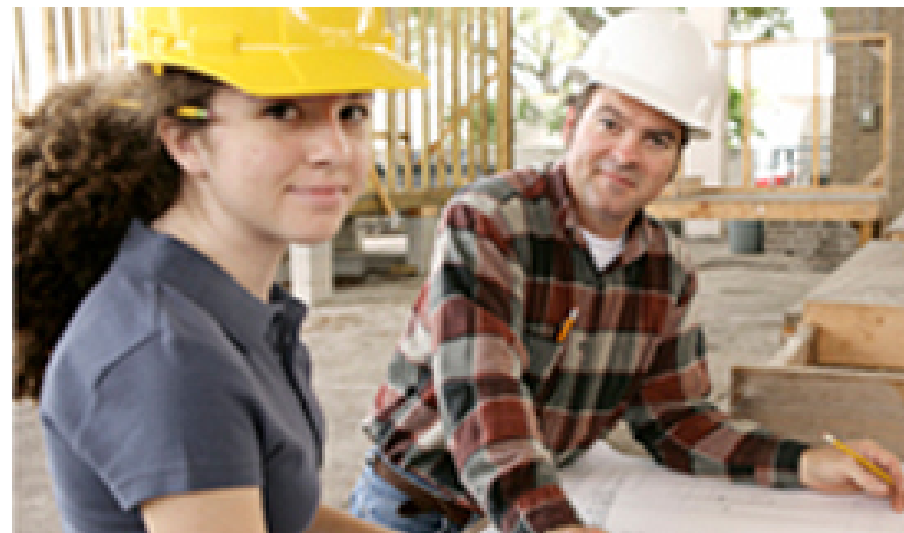

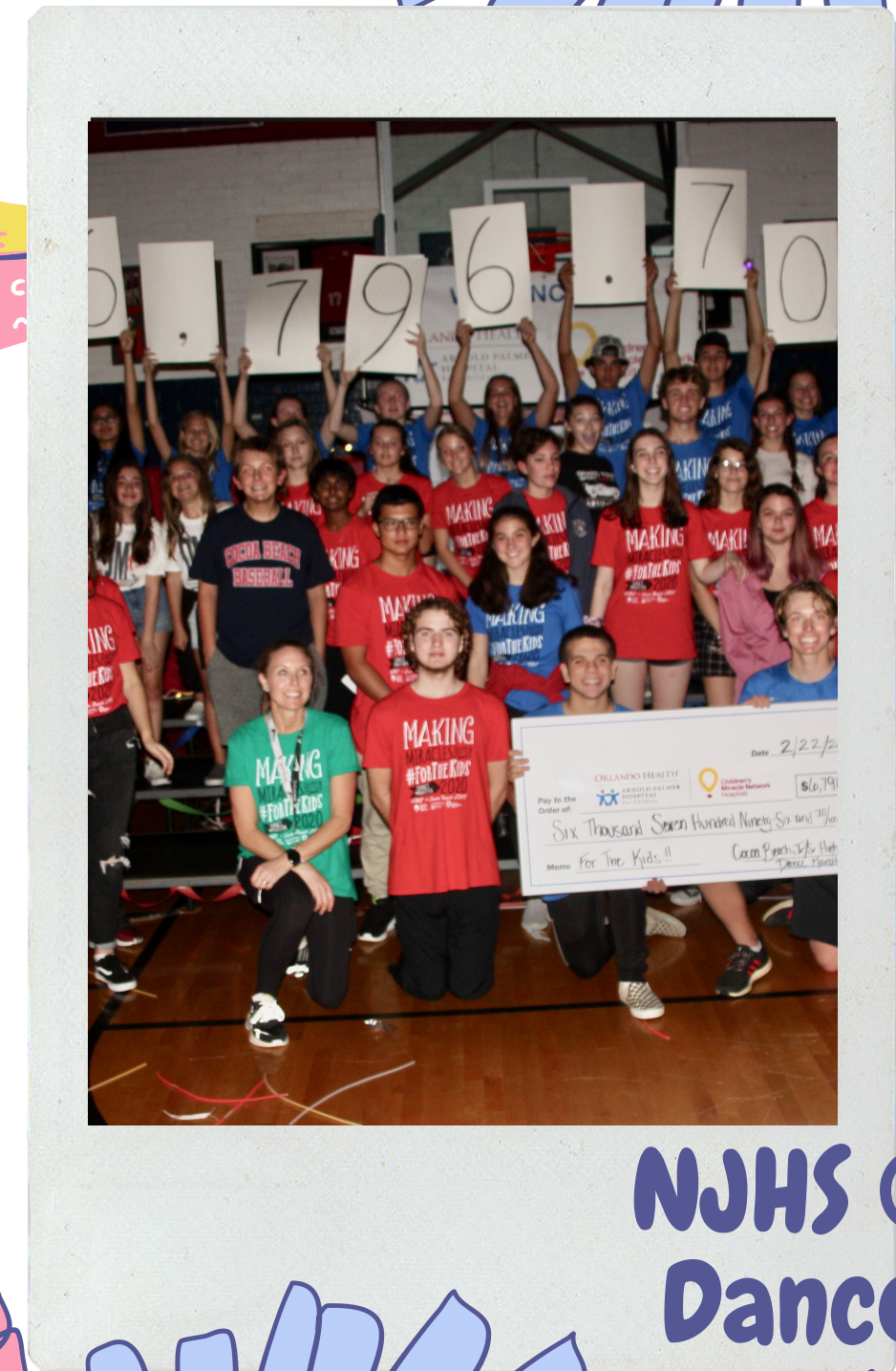
